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Many players have progressed on from the TSC Scholarship to play semi-professionally as well as several players receiving scholarships to play and study in the USA.

The TSC Post 16 Football scholarship is for players who want to reach their potential as a footballer.

TSC Scholarship programme has a progressive structure with Development and Elite streams.

Our development streams which run directly from St Georges School and Ursuline College will compete in the Kent Academies League, with the Elite stream representing Ramsgate FC in the National Youth Alliance League.

All players will train 2-3 times a week and compete in the respective leagues, players will have the opportunity to move between the development and Elite streams based on their performance and development.

All training sessions and games take place during the school timetable alongside each players academic studies. The scholarship places high priority on the players academics, our partnerships with both the Ursuline College and St Georges allow us to offer a wide range of A level and Vocational qualifications so that all players in the programme can receive an excellent education.

Fixtures are filmed to allow players to review their performance with footage being used for analysis work to help players improve. All players receive coaching from highly qualified, experienced, and professional football coaches.

A full fitness programme including SAQ work, strength and conditioning work, with individual training programmes and structured, periodical fitness testing. Each player will receive training on individual technical ability and tactical understanding to prepare them for a potential future in the game. Goalkeepers will also receive goalkeeper specific training from TSC's Goalkeeper Coaches.

Many players have progressed on from the TSC Scholarship to play semi-professionally as well as several players receiving scholarships to play and study in the USA. Our Elite stream link with Ramsgate Football Club provides a clear pathway for players to move into semi-professional football at a respected local club.

All players will be given the opportunity to take coaching badges and earn a qualification which can lead to a career in coaching or other areas of sport. We will fully fund each players Introduction to Coaching Footballers Course which may also lead to potential employment with TSC for those who wish to take on coaching as a career. Several of our former scholars now work full time for us as coaches after moving from school into an apprenticeship with us.

All players will also receive a Nike kit package which they wear during the school day.



The Sixth Form at Ursuline College offers fantastic opportunities for students to study and further their skills with excellent and innovative teaching, thereby enabling students to gain the qualifications and experiences needed to access university, further education and the careers of their choice.

We are very proud of the Sixth Form at Ursuline College and the achievements of our students. In 2023, a third of students studying academic A-Level qualifications achieved grades A*- B and over two thirds of students achieved a C grade or higher. Our vocational programmes boast impressive results with 50% of students achieving a Distinction (A equivalent) or higher and over 90% achieving a merit (C equivalent) or higher. These students have progressed to

study a wide range of subjects including Business, Biomedical Science, Clinical Psychology, Computer Science, Criminology, Education, English Literature, Forensics, History, International Relations, Journalism, Law, Nursing, Paramedic Science, Sport Science and Sport Therapy. Training for the Elite Squad will take place at the excellent facilities in the WW Martin Community Stadium, which will also be the venue for home fixtures.

We offer Goalkeeper Specific coaching to players who play in this position. These sessions are run by qualified coaches with experience of working with goalkeepers.

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


GCAGEMY ACABEMY

As well as our playing scholarship we also run a coaching academy. The coaching academy is for sixth form pupils who have an interest in entering the world of sports coaching, teaching, in sport. The 2-year course will run alongside the students' academic studies, during the specific programme, coaches can choose to specialise in a particular sport that they have a passion for, or can take a more multi-sport focus.
